



# FOIL BURRITO HANDLING INSTRUCTIONS



KEEP PRODUCT REFRIGERATED - code date product 7 days after thaw

## THAWING:

Defrost frozen burritos under refrigeration.  
Thaw for 24-48 hours before heating.

## HEATING:



### Conventional Oven:

Heat defrosted burritos in a regular or toaster oven at 350°F for 25 minutes, or 325°F for 30 minutes. Oven temperatures may vary. Do not overheat.



### Pizza Oven:

Place burritos on a baking sheet. Heat for 10-12 minutes on one side. Using oven mitts, remove baking sheet from oven and flip burritos to opposite side. Heat again for an additional 10-12 minutes until internal temperature reaches 165°F.



NOTE: Product internal temperature must reach 165°F before serving. Test temperature with a pocket thermometer for accuracy.

## LABELING HOLDING:

Label each burrito with the proper flavor label. Code each burrito with the appropriate hot-hold time. Place under a heat lamp or in a foodservice hot-hold warmer unit on medium high to hold for 4 to 6 hours. Discard product after 6 hours hot-hold.



NOTE: Burritos will not reheat under a heat lamp. Never microwave burritos wrapped in foil packaging.

### Quality Standards:

1. Product temperature must reach 165°F and hold at 140°F.
2. Test internal temperature with a thermometer for accuracy.
3. Heat burritos only once.
4. Burrito foil packaging must be clean and unbroken when placed for sale.
5. Display burritos with label face up and forward for flavor identification.
